Florescent Cattle Markers or Spray Paint

Vaccination Records, Health Certificate, Coggins Report

Medical History & Any Medications

Proof of Ownership (in waterproof bag)

- Photos
- Microchip/Brand/Tattoo Numbers
- Age, Breed, Sex, Physical Description

First Aid Kit

- Bandages
- Adhesive Wraps
- Gauze Pads
- Wraps and Quilts
- Scissors & Hemostats
