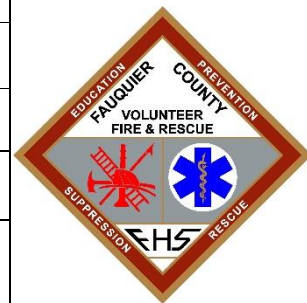

This Instructor I course curriculum is based on the NFPA 1041-12 Standard for Fire Service Instructor Professional Qualifications. The Instructor I Certification Course contains 21 hours of student lectures, 5 hours of group activities, and 16 hours of required individual presentations for a total of 42 hours, plus time for written and skills testing.
